SECRETARY'S REPORT

Meeting Minutes - September 12, 2013

The monthly meeting of the Kenan Quilters' Guild was called to order at 7:05 PM by President, Linda Davis. There were no new members or guests present.

Committees:

Comfort Quilts-Marge Sposito will remain on this committee.

Nominating-Pat Tracy & Maria Adams will remain on this committee. One additional member is needed. Anyone who is interested can contact Linda.

Raffle Quilt 2015-Sue McKenna has a paper piecing pattern picked out.

Raffle Quilt 2014-Linda Davis & Judy Schryver have chosen a pattern and have the fabric. The design is a combination of piecing & applique. The finished size is 96" X 80". Packets for the piecing portion will be handed out to the membership in December. The central motif is a basket of flowers which will be appliqued.

Publicity-Mae Andes will remain on this committee.

Round Robin-Marge Sposito will remain on this committee. The quilt is currently still in circulation.

2015 Quilt Show Chairs-For ease in transition from one show to the next it is customary for one of the current show chairs to remain. Therefore, an additional person will be needed to help chair the next show.

Reports:

Secretary-Since there was no formal meeting for the month of August there were no minutes to be approved.

Treasurer-The proposed budget was presented in the last newsletter.

Gail advised the group of the following changes:

1. Under the heading, DESIGNATED FUND CARRYOVER, a figure of \$1,000.00 needs to be added to the Local Nat'l teacher (projected expense cell) and \$350.00 needs to be added to the Local Nat'l teacher (projected income cell).
2. Under the heading, GEN. FUND. PROJECTED EXPENSE, cross out the \$1100 figure which appears in the box labeled QS13-programs. The cost of the programs is being offset by the advertising. Pat Tracy made a motion to accept the proposed budget and MarySue Rogers seconded the motion. A vote was taken and the budget passed.

Cuddle Quilts-Bev Rosenberg announced that kits were available to be taken. She will need some tops to be

tied at the quilt show.

Challenge-Pat Tracy is looking for ideas for the yearly challenge. She is thinking of having an "Unfinished Project" challenge as a meeting program in the future. She is happy to hear from anyone who may have an idea.

Liaison-Linda attended the "special meeting" of the Kenan affiliates. She presented a page full of coming events that the Kenan would like us to participate in. Nancy Smith & MarySue Rogers will obtain more information about the Beer Fest Event in particular. Raffle Quilt Ticket Sales-Sue McKenna needs 2 people to work at the raffle quilt table for the "Autumn in the Arena" event being held at the Kenan on Saturday. Dottie Timkey passed out raffle quilt tickets to those who hadn't received them yet.

Quilt Show-Sue McKenna announced that quilts in the show are not being judged this year. There are 10 local organizations which will each be giving an award in addition to 3 Guild awards. Sue is looking for 3 members to serve as judges to select the quilt which will receive "Best of Show". She announced that committee chairs will be circulating sign-up sheets next month to man their specific areas of the quilt show. She is also looking for people to do demos. Sandy Diel announced that she is accepting items for the Chinese Auction. Martha Krupa announced that Boutique drop off will coincide with quilt drop off. Anyone interested in putting something in the Boutique can contact Martha. Linda encouraged everyone to actively participate in the upcoming quilt show.

Traveling Quilt Show- Dottie Timkey announced the visit to Basset Manor on Friday.

New Business:

Book-Katie DerSarkissian passed around a flier with information about a new quilt book, Three Sisters by Nancilou Burdick.

QUILTING TIP OF THE MONTH

Stash Management

(from Madelyne Kiernan of St. James, NY)


When storing fabric I use my 6" x 24" ruler to fold the fabric. Leave the fabric folded as it comes off the bolt from the store. Lay your ruler along the cut edge and start to fold the fabric over the ruler. When all of the fabric is folded, slip the ruler out and fold the fabric in half. It will be neatly folded, uniformly sized and easy to stack.



IT'S A MYSTERY - STEPS FOUR AND FIVE

Step 4: Summer Breeze

A Judy Hopkins Mystery




Make 48

Join the 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" LIGHT rectangles to the units you made in Step 3 to make 48 units that look like this.

Press seams toward the DARK fabric. The units should measure 4-1/2" x 4-1/2" (raw edge to raw edge) when sewn.

Step 5: Summer Breeze

A Judy Hopkins Mystery



Make 12

Join the units you made in Step 4 to make 12 traditional WINDMILL blocks.


Press seams consistently, either all toward or all away from the DARK squares. To accomplish this, you will have to twist the final seam when pressing.

The blocks should measure 8-1/2" x 8-1/2" (raw edge to raw edge) when sewn.
